Expectations for Academic Success	
1.	I understand that if I need accommodations as part of an IEP and/or 504 plan I will submit all necessary documentation to the <u>Accommodations Submission Form</u> or to <u>ucscoutaccommodations@ucsc.edu</u> .
2.	I have created a copy of the provided pacing guide and entered my course start and end dates. I have saved it and will refer to it to ensure I complete the course in a timely manner.
3.	I have selected an Observer to support my progress through my UC Scout course(s) and they have been added to my course.
4.	If I have a question, I will email my teacher at any time using the Inbox accessible in the Global Navigation. I can expect a response within 24 regular business hours, 8 a.m.–5 p.m. PDT/PST, Monday–Friday, excluding holidays.
5.	Once registration for the course has closed, my missing assignments will be marked late leading up to the course end date. Late assignments will receive a zero in the grade book but may still be submitted until the course end date. Upon submission, the zero will be replaced with the grade earned.
6.	I will review the assignment settings and applicable time and submission limits before I begin. Assignment, quiz, and test settings may differ.
7.	I will complete the course in sequential order; this means that I cannot skip around (e.g., I will not be allowed to do the Unit 2 assignments without completing Unit 1 assignments, etc.)
8.	Once my Final Exam is submitted, the course is considered complete. I may not go back to redo assignments, and my teacher may submit my grade at this point.
9.	I will not submit "placeholder" submissions in lieu of submitting a completed assignment (in an effort to bypass the prerequisite settings).
	A placeholder is any submission intended to fill a required assignment constraint without meeting the actual assignment criteria.
	If I am found doing this, my ability to submit future assignments may be suspended; making this practice a habit (2 or more times) may result in a zero on the Final Exam.

10.	I will submit original work. If academic integrity has been breached, a zero is earned, and more severe consequences may be enforced in accordance with UC Scout Course Policies .	
11.	I understand that all required assignments may be subject to textual similarity review via Turnitin for the detection of plagiarism. All submitted assignments may be included as source documents in the Turnitin reference database solely for the purpose of detecting plagiarism of such assignments. I may submit my papers in such a way that no identifying information about me is included.
